Reverend Crosby spoke about the Modesto Police Clergy Council. Reverend Crosby moved to California from Louisiana in 1970. He was brutalized by police at an early age. He never understood why they did that but as a result he developed a hatred for police. His father offered that "it's not what you do that determines who you are, it is who you are that determines what you do." His life changed when competing in a 400 meter high hurdle race in Venezuela. When he crossed the finish line, he heard the announcement "the American won". It was the first time he had been called an American without reference to race. He started a quest to interact with law enforcement in a positive way. For the past 28 years he has been instrumental in the Modesto Police Clergy Council.
